

Community Connections Coordinator - Job Description

Purpose

This is one of three 'Community Catalyst' roles. Reporting to Unite Foundation's All of Us Programme Manager, the purpose of a Community Catalyst role is to support the growth of personal interaction within the All of Us community. We want to improve connections between, and build community for, care experienced and estranged students. This role is a 6-month (plus induction) post that will also be a learning opportunity for both the charity and the student in post.

Specific Responsibilities

- Encourage and support members of the community to connect with one another, generate their own content and/or shape content creation. Try and test novel ways to help members connect with each other both within MN and wider afield.
- Fulfil our 'Jar of Jewels' approach: create content that lets community members know about the activities of other charities, student groups and organisations in the sector.
- Create varied posts each month on the community's <u>online platform</u>, monitoring responses, assessing activity and engagement. Proactively make suggestions for improvements/changes that will improve the community experience: keep track of this decision making and track progress over the months.
- Work with our Programme Manager to select three individualised Areas of Focus to focus your community-catalysing efforts around.
- Willingness to take on feedback and develop skills and knowledge, to integrate into Unite Foundation methods and procedures. Comply with organisational policies including data protection, brand, and safeguarding.

Key Personal Requirements

- Be a current UK Higher Education student from a care experienced and/or estranged background. Students must also join the online platform: https://thisisusatuni.mn.co/
- A positive, pro-active ethic, mindful of safe working practices
- Genuine interest in boosting peer-connection and in the wider sector and external opportunities (e.g. what is happening in other charities).
- Content producer with appropriate communication skills
- Ability to manage own time effectively, prioritising tasks when required

You will be able to access training and development opportunities as appropriate.

Salary: Real Living Wage @£13.15 per hour, 12 hours per month (during office hours), and additional agreed time for meeting attendance, training, and blog creation; to fit around your



studies/commitments.
